
Revelation 11

1 Then I was given a reed like a measuring rod. And the angel stood, saying, "Rise and measure the temple of God, the altar, and those who worship there. 2 But leave out the court, which is outside the temple, and do not measure it, for it has been given to the Gentiles. And they will tread the holy city underfoot for forty-two months. 3 And I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth." 4 These are the two olive trees and the two lampstands standing before the God of the earth. 5 And if anyone wants to harm them, fire proceeds from their mouth and devours their enemies. And if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this manner. 6 These have power to shut heaven, so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy; and they have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to strike the earth with all plagues, as often as they desire. 7 When they finish their

testimony, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit will make war against them, overcome them, and kill them. 8 And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified. 9 Then those from the peoples, tribes, tongues, and nations will see their dead bodies three-and-a-half days, and not allow their dead bodies to be put into graves. 10 And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them, make merry, and send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth. 11 Now after the three-and-a-half days the breath of life from God entered them, and they stood on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them. 12 And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here." And they ascended to heaven in a cloud and their enemies saw them. 13 In the same hour there was a great earthquake, and a tenth of the city fell. In the earthquake seven thousand people were killed, and the rest were afraid and gave glory to the God of heaven. 14 The second woe is pst. Take Aways

- 1) As we saw in this chapter, the two witnesses were clothed in sackcloth, which represents a call to repentance.
- 2) Jesus didn't commit the gospel to an advertising agency; He commissioned you and me to be a witness to the world we are currently living in.
- 3) You may not be an expert on quoting every scripture, but **you are an expert** on what **Jesus has done in your life**.
- 4) The Holy Spirit is faithful to empower your testimony, making your story a powerful witness to others.
- 5) The two witnesses came under great persecution, as does the church today in many parts of the world.

- 1) Are you comfortable or uncomfortable sharing your personal testimony?
- 2) Are you willing to be ridiculed or persecuted for the sake of the gospel?
- 3) Does your lifestyle at home or at work consistently represent the Lord?
